Getting here by bus



The closest bus stop is Trident Way Bridge, which is only a 3-minute walk away from MAPA. There are several buses that will take you there from Bradford Interchange Bus Station:

Buses 363, 686, 687 and 688 from Odsal.

Bus 645 between Buttershaw and Eccleshill.

Buses 681 and 682 from Halifax.

Getting here by car

If travelling via the M62, go onto Rooley Ln (A6177) in Bradford, then take exit 3 from M606. Continue on A6177, then take Manchester Rd (A641) to Cotewall Rd.

If travelling from Bradford City Centre, drive along Manchester Rd (A641) then take Ryan St to Cotewall Rd. It will take you around 10 minutes to drive there from the City Centre.

MAPA has a free car park in front of the venue.

When you arrive

MAPA's main entrance will be to your left, if walking up from the car park. There is step-free access throughout the venue.



As you enter, you'll be greeted by a member of the CVF team in the reception area.

Toilets, including an accessible toilet, will be right behind the welcome desk.

The meeting will take place in the Sports Hall, located just off the main room, less than a minute walk away from the welcome desk.
