Welcome to the National Science and Media Museum

The museum will be hosting the next CVF Members Meeting and AGM on Wednesday 30 April. It wil take place in Cubby Broccoli cinema on the first floor of the museum (Level 1).

This visual story contains information on how to get to the museum by bus, train or car, and what to expect once you're there.

Getting here by bus

Most bus routes to Bradford have stops within walking distance from the museum.

Buses 656, 614, 612 from Shipley, 653 from Baildon, 641, 660 from Idle, and 645 from Wibsey stop at Bradford Interchange Bus Station (6 min walk from the museum).

Bus 67 from Thornton stops at City Park B (3 min walk).

Bus 640 from Idle stops at Senior Way. (3 min walk).

Bus 613 from Wibsey and 576 from Queensbury stop at the Ice Arena (3 min walk).

Getting here by train

The museum is a 6-min walk away from Bradford Interchange Station, and 15 minutes away from Bradford Forster Square. From both train stations, the route is signposted all the way to the museum.

Getting here by car

From the M62, take Junction 26 onto the M606 and follow the brown tourist signs on your approach to Bradford City Centre.

There is a pick-up and drop-off point outside the main museum entrance.

The nearest car parks are Sharpe Street (right behind the museum) and Radwell Drive. There are multi-storey car parks at Broadway and Southgate.

There are three parking spaces for blue badge holders at the front of the museum. These have a maximum stay time of 4 hours.

If you parked in Sharpe St car park, you can enter the museum through the link door entrance at the rear. Push button to open the doors, then turn left into the museum foyer.

Getting here by bicycle

If you are cycling to the museum, you can store your bike in one of the 7 lockers available at the rear of the museum – just ask a member of staff for the key.

When you arrive

A member of CVF staff will greet you in the foyer.

From 10.30am, there will be pre-meeting activities, networking, and a hot drink station on the first floor (Level 1) landing. It's one flight of stairs up from the foyer level, and there is an option to get there via a lift.

Between 10.45 and 11.00am, and 1pm and 2pm, you can explore YOU:MATTER, an interactive gallery on the same floor. The gallery entrance will be on your right if you get there via the stairs, and in front of you if you get there via a lift.

Both the Members Meeting (11.00-11.50am) and the Annual General Meeting (12.00-1pm) will take place in Cubby Broccoli cinema.
