

Welcome to Hive Bradford

39b Kirkgate, Shipley BD18 3EH

Hive Bradford is hosting the next CVF Members Meeting on Thursday 18 September. It is located in the same building as Kirkgate Centre. This visual story contains information on how to get to Hive by bus, train or car, where to park, and what to expect once you're there.

Getting here by bus

There are several local buses that stop at the Shipley Market Square, a 2-3 minute walk from Hive:

Buses 676 and 678 between Cottingley and Bradford.

Buses 656 and 626 between Baildon and Bradford.

Bus 622 between Bingley and Bradford.

Buses 634, 633, and A3 from Bradford.

Getting here by train



Closest train station is Shipley (Yorks), located a 10 minute walk away.

Saltire station is a 17 minute walk away.

There are also regular trains between the Saltire and Shipley stations.

Getting here by car

From the M62, leave at Junction 26 and continue to the end of the M606.

Follow signs for the A650 through Bradford until the road's end at a T-junction on a steep slope with traffic lights.

Turn right onto Otley Road, keep left then take a left turn after a crossroads next to Subway. Kirkgate centre will be on the right, opposite the Town Hall.

Take the first right turn into Crowgill Road to enter the free car park at the venue. There are 10 parking spaces.

There is additional on-street parking in front of the Kirkgate centre, which is free after 5pm.



When you arrive

Hive is located in the same building as the Kirkgate Centre.

If you enter through the black iron gates, there is a path on the right of the building leading down to the entrance to Hive. This path has a slight decline and a few steps.

If you turn left just before the gate, go along the fence and around the building, there is step-free access from Crowgill Road.

There is also a lift on the ground floor inside the Kirkgate Centre that can take you to Hive.

Hive is a step-free venue.

Once you enter, the welcome desk will be on your left. You will be greeted by a member of the CVF team.

Toilets are located in the entrance area next to the welcome desk. There are 2 gender-neutral and 1 accessible toilet.

The meeting will take place in the main area next to the pottery and woodwork workshops.

At the front of the room, there is a welfare space where the refreshments will be set up for the meeting.

There is a quiet space available at the opposite end of the venue.
